## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE SALZ & ÖL RALLY 2019



## **GENERAL:**

This sporting event is a fast and fair regularity rally (aka. TSD). Prevailing road traffic regulations must be obeyed at all times. Bad weather can adversely affect the implementation of the event.

Severe violations of road traffic regulations or unsporting behaviour shall lead to exclusion of the competitor from the competition. The organiser accepts no liability for the safety of competitors. On signing the registration form, each competitor declares his/her intention to participate in the rally at his/her own risk.

Each stage of the course must be driven fairly quickly and can be completed if navigated correctly. Good navigation of the course – and not high speed – is the goal here. We urge all competitors not to breach the trust placed in the organisers by the authorities. We request you give the best possible impression of motor sports enthusiasts. Please adapt your driving style to all prevailing external circumstances, and to your personal circumstances, such as the condition and age of the car, and your own skill levels.

The cars are classed according to the year in which they were manufactured and given starting numbers accordingly. The oldest car begins the race with the number 1. Cars will be divided into the three following construction period classes:

Class 1: Cars manufactured on or before 31.12.1965 Class 2: Cars manufactured on or before 31.12.1975 Class 3: Cars manufactured on or before 31.12.1985

Prescribed average speeds and stage times are the same for all classes and can, provided the route is navigated correctly, be achieved by all drivers.

## **SCORING:**

Points allocated/deducted for deviation from prescribed driving times for the individual stages, and points awarded on the special rally stages, are added together for a total score per competitor.

The secret scores (GK) are measured in 100ths of a second. Points will be allocated/deducted for missing checkpoint time entries in the rally card.

The participation fee is € 900 per team. This also covers the evening meal on Friday, lunch on Saturday, and the evening meal at the award ceremony later on Saturday. Drinks are also included.

The cost of overnight accommodation on Friday night is not included in the participation fee! Please make sure you book your accommodation for the night of Friday, 18.10.2019 in good time.

The award ceremony is to take place at the Arena City Hotel Salzburg/expo hotel.

The enclosed rally participation form must be filled in correctly and completely, and be received by the organiser: S.R.C. – Reichenhallerstraße 7, A-5020 Salzburg, on or before the deadline for entries of 17.09.2019.

Applications will only be accepted if the participation fee can be proven to have been paid via bank transfer (paying-in slip), or if sent accompanied by a valid cheque. The field of competitors must be limited. The organiser cannot guarantee participation!

At the start, each team receives a road book and a time card. These time cards will be collected by race management at the end of every run for score evaluation purposes.

The event closes after the award ceremony on Saturday which is expected to commence at approximately 7pm.

The 'Salz & Öl' 2019 rally is held in conjunction with the Classic Expo fair.

The rally starts and finishes on the grounds of the exhibition centre on Friday and Saturday.
